The Tea Burner 5K Run and 1 Mile Run/Walk, held in memory of Mayor Wally Goodwin, will kick off the annual Cumberland County Historical Society's Artisans' Faire.

All race proceeds benefit the C. Wallis Goodwin Memorial Scholarship Fund and the Greenwich Volunteer Fire and Rescue Squad.

The 5K course starts at the Morris Goodwin School and takes you past the Faire on historic Ye Greate Street lined by colonial homes, to Market Lane by a local marina on the Cohansey River and scenic marshland, to Pier Road with farms in view, then on to Bacons Neck Road and finally back to Ye Greate Street. There will be water stations along the route and refreshments at the end!

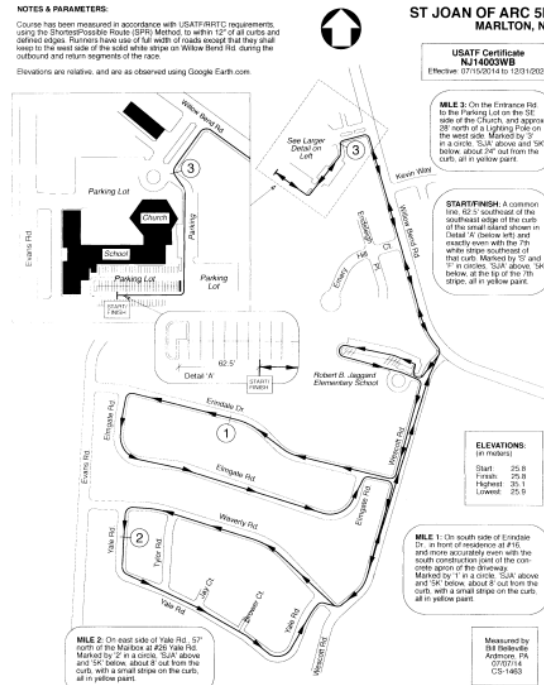

NOTES & PARAMETERS:

Course has been measured in accordance with USATF/IBUFI requirements, using the Shortest Possible Route (SPR) Method, to within 1% of all curves and defined edges. Runners have use of full width of roads except that they shall keep to the west side of the solid white area on Willow Street during the outbound and return segments of the race.

Elevations are relative, and are as observed using Google Earth.com.

MILE 3: On the Entrance Rd to the Parking Lot on the SE side of the Church, and approx. 20' north of a Lighting Pole on the west side. Marked by '3' in a circle. 'SJA' above and '5K' below, about 24" out from the curb, all in yellow paint.

START/FINISH: A common line, 42" southeast of the southeast edge of the curb of the small island shown in Detail 'X' (below left) and exactly even with the 75' white stripe southeast of that curb. Marked by '3' and '1' in circles. 'SJA' above, '5K' below, at the top of the stripe, all in yellow paint.

ELEVATIONS: (ft. meters) Start: 25.8 (7.8) Finish: 25.8 (7.8) Highest: 25.1 (7.6) Lowest: 25.9 (7.9)

MILE 1: On south side of Engle Rd, at fork of road shown at #16, and more accurately even with the south curbstone line east of the concrete gutter of the driveway. Marked by '1' in a circle. 'SJA' above and '5K' below, about 8" out from the curb, with a small stripe on the curb, all in yellow paint.

MILE 2: On east side of Yale Rd, 57' north of the Maltese at Yale Rd. Marked by '2' in a circle. 'SJA' above and '5K' below, about 8" out from the curb, with a small stripe on the curb, all in yellow paint.
